Announcements included the fact that Larry and Carol Otto had a new son, Carl Ray Otto, born in March 1984. Deaths reported were Donald E. Hybee, June 23 and Opal Hybee Tracy, Sept. 3, 1984.

It was announced that Glenn and Irene Hybee had been King and Queen of the Arkansas Valley in 1983. and Martha and Phil Gelbert had that honor in 1984.

It was also announced that Glen and Irene Higbee would ~~be~~ celebrated their 50th anniversary in June and that Masha and Phil Gilbert would celebrate theirs in December.

It was announced that the picnic would be in the same place on July 21st in 1985.

The meeting adjourned for watermelon and ice cream.
